In total, seven speaking test sessions are scheduled throughout May across all three examination centres - Nicosia, Limassol, and Paphos - with Larnaca following in June. Around 2200 candidates are scheduled to take their oral exams in English, and we would like to wish every one of them the very best of luck in their tests. Most importantly, however, we hope that all candidates have a positive and rewarding experience. We encourage everyone to arrive at the exam centre feeling calm, confident, and ready to do their best without unnecessary stress or anxiety.

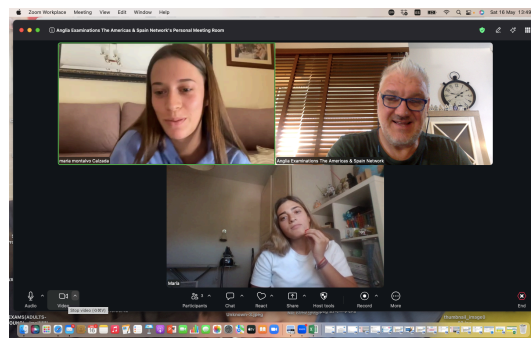
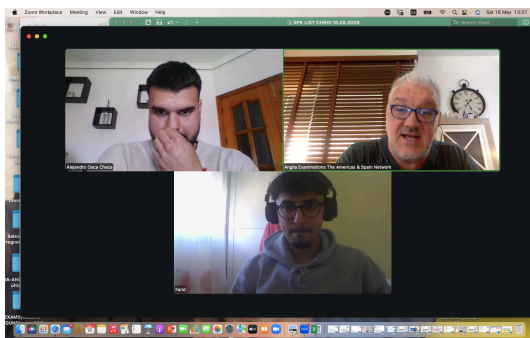
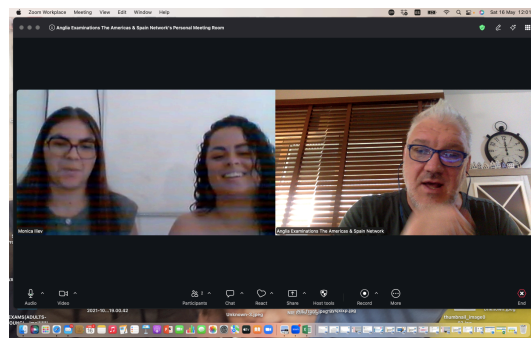
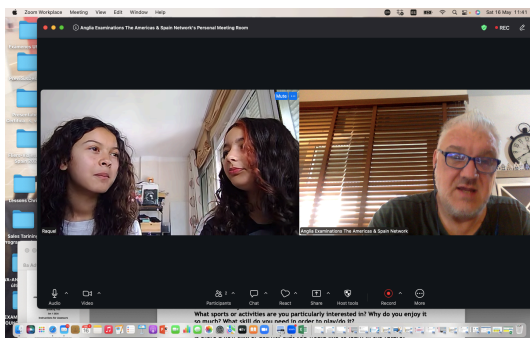


excellence in English language education. Each month brings new milestones, and this one is no exception.

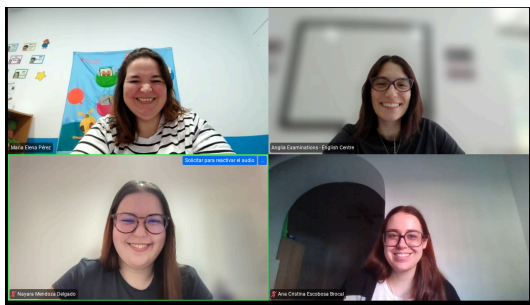
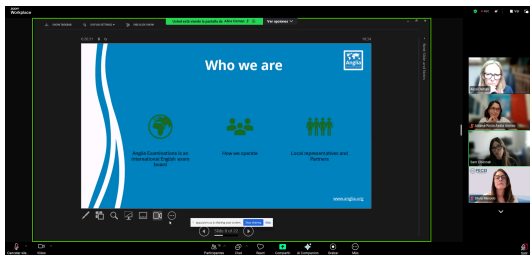
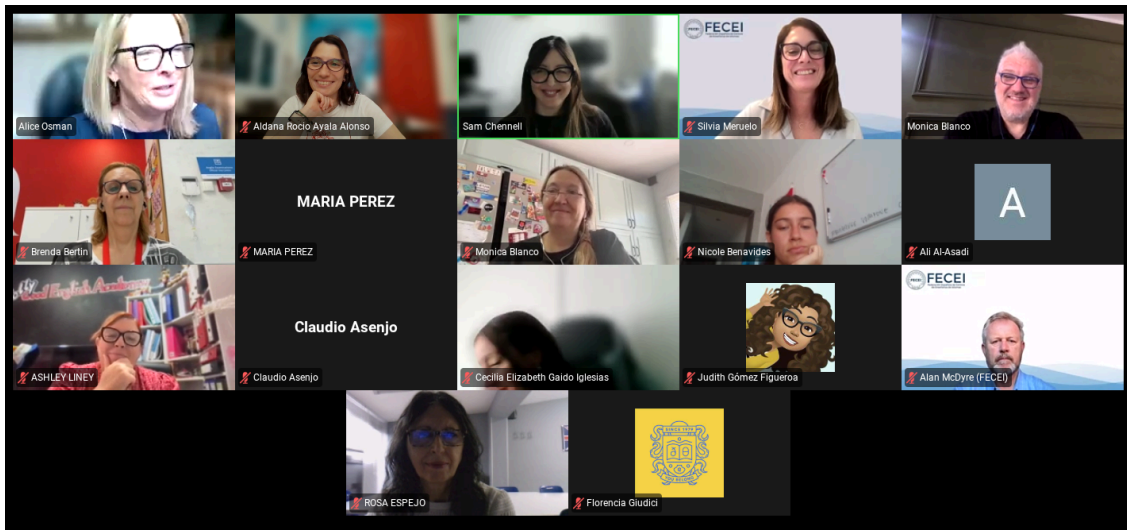

This month also marks the successful completion of our latest Examer Training Programme.

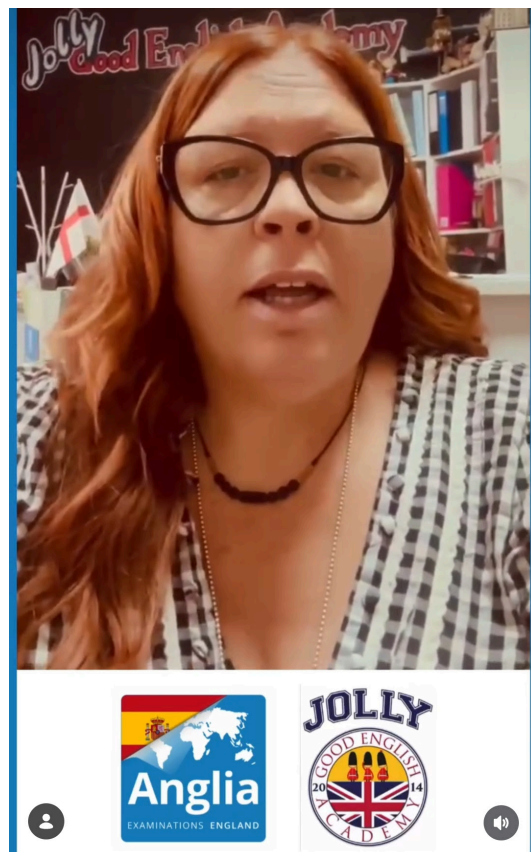
We are proud to welcome a new group of trained professionals who are now ready to uphold Anglia's standards in assessment.

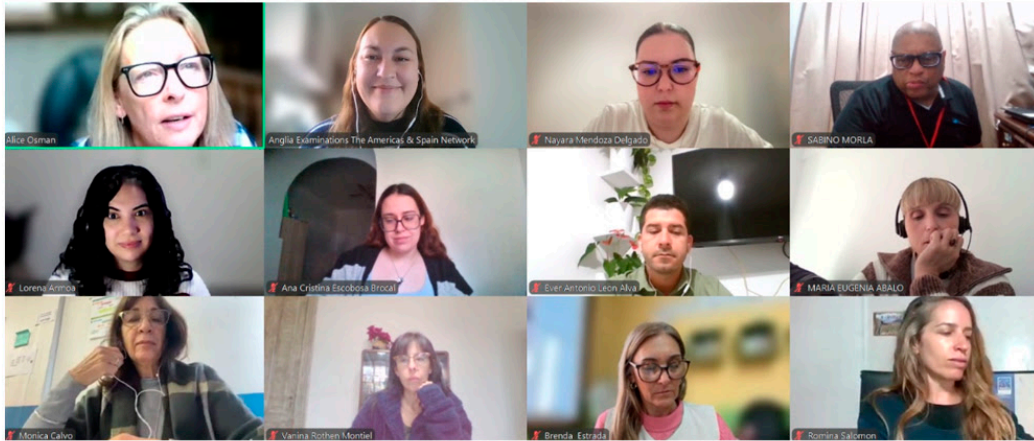

Examiner Training Programme

Our Examiner Training Programme continued throughout May with sessions led by Chris Kunz, Alice Osman, Debbie Gibbs, Karen Griffiths, Alex Greco, Monica Blanco-Kunz and Estefania Krogulec. Trainees from different countries across the region worked on the assessment process, speaking exam tasks, sample materials, and the core principles that guide Anglia examining. The programme is now moving towards its final stage, bringing new certified Anglia examiners closer to joining the network.

- **Task 1:** Introductory warm-up (up to 4 mins.)
- **Task 2:** Discussion of recent issues in the news (up to 8 mins.) *
- **Task 3:** Semi-prepared topic for discussion (up to 8 mins.)

* Requires preparation by the candidate



ADULT LEARNER STEP 4 (6-11 mins. for 2 candidates)

- **Task 1:** Introduction (1-2 minutes)
 - **Task 2:** Telling a story from pictures (3 mins). The examiner starts the story in the past.
 - **Task 3:** Spot the difference information gap exercise (3 mins) pictures given (ask & answer)
- **No preparation by the candidate.**
